




# Jamaica

## Memo from Pastor Dumaresq, Mar 09, 2020

#### Praise the Lord saints at TNT.

We all have been challenged by the COVID-19 pandemic sweeping the globe. The unprecedented reactions to this crisis, especially in regard to the recommendations by governments concerning public assembly and social distancing, have been particularly challenging.

Here in British Columbia, the most recent maximum number being presented for acceptable public assembly is fifty, while just this past week it was two hundred and fifty. After great consideration concerning the course of action TNT should take at this time, we have decided to implement a few temporary measures to be introduced this coming Sunday.

- 1. We will be only holding Worship Service beginning at 10:45 am and suspending Sunday School of all ages.
- 2. We will be Limiting the number of persons in our sanctuary to 49, with any beyond this number being directed to overflow worship area located in the fellowship area downstairs.
- 3. We will be streaming a live feed of the entire service to the TNT Facebook page, which will be displayed downstairs, and also available for those unable to attend to view, and worship in their homes.
- 4. We will be observing Social distancing recommendations, instructing everyone to not hug, or shake hands and to have an empty chair between you and your fellow worshiper.
- 5. For Wednesday Evening Bible Study, will be suspending assembly at the church, but presenting a live feed bible study from the pastor's office, to your homes.

Naturally we do not want anyone ill to be in attendance, so please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms of fever, coughing etc.. We also understand that some people who are feeling fine, may choose not to attend, in which case we encourage those to join in via the TNT Facebook page.

It is vital that the Church, continues to be the Church, especially in the midst of trying times as these. It is also important to exercise wisdom and maintain a good witness in our community. For these reasons we will continue to make adjustments as needed, week by week. We do encourage and exhort everyone in the TNT family to maintain their own personal devotion to the Lord, and not regress spiritually during this difficult and disruptive time.

In closing, remember to trust in the Lord with all you heart and don't give in to fear. The Church will be victorious because Jesus is Lord!
