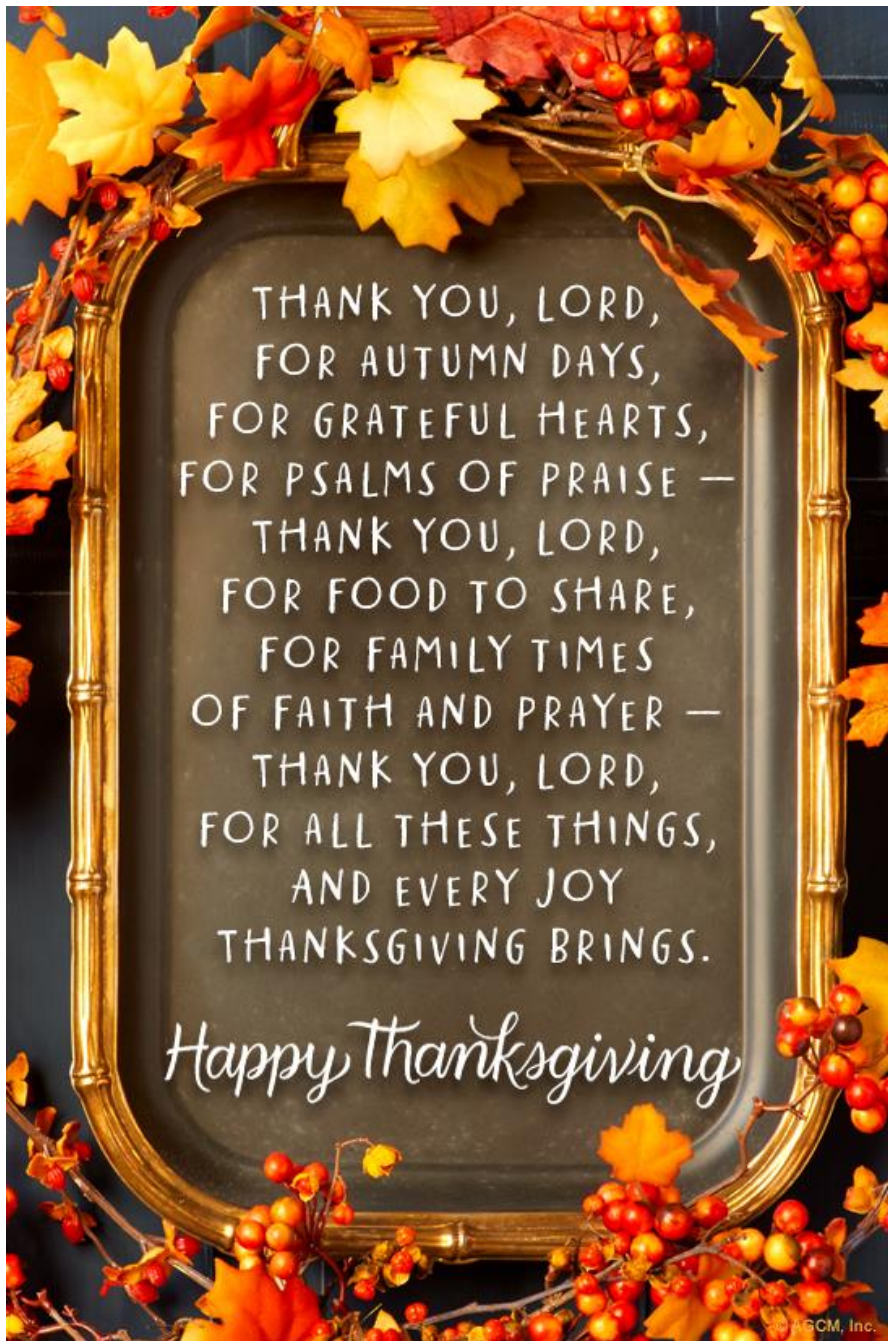


OUR PRAYER PARTNERS AT BIBLE WAY APOSTOLIC CHURCH, JAMAICA
