ORDER OF THE B.C. PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICER

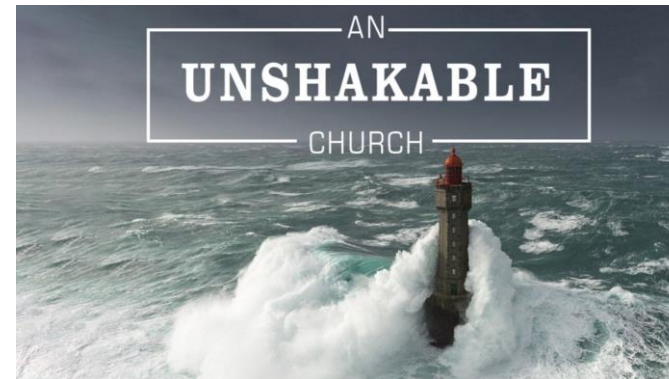
Updated January 07, 2021

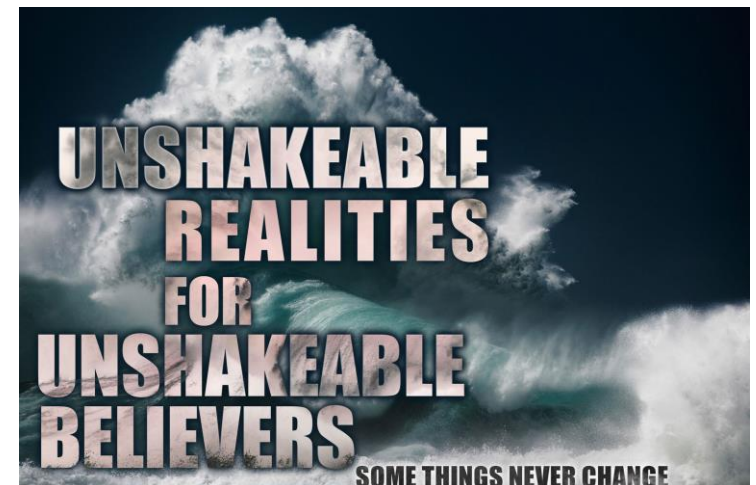

OUR PRAYER PARTNERS AT BIBLE WAY APOSTOLIC CHURCH, JAMAICA

Prayer requests

- **We pray for the front-line workers across the world who is working assiduously to fight the coronavirus.** We have seen an increase in the number of cases here in Jamaica since it was first picked up on Tuesday March 10th. We have recorded 13,992 cases, 1,870 are active, 323 persons died, and 11,630 persons have recovered to up January 7th.
 - **Bereaved** – the family of Elder Smith, bro Chavoun and Annecia -they lost their mother, Missy Verona Peart lost her sister-in-law.
 - **Kaylan Dowdie** – She remains in Intensive Care on ventilator. She suffered a C2 spinal injury which is making it difficult for her to breathe on her own. She underwent surgery in late December to have a pacemaker inserted. She has been making improvement.
 - **Andrew Standifer** – he is having some challenges.
 - **Douglas Freeman** – he suffered a stroke in November last year.
 - **Bro. Noel Morgan**- He is suffering from arthritic pain in his legs.
 - **Sis. Kesita Sturridge** - She is having thyroid problem and may require surgery.
 - **Persons battling with cancer** - Ms. Bora, Jquani and Ms. Watson.
 - **Persons battling Covid-19** across the world.
 - **Mr. Livingston Morgan** – he is currently undergoing dialysis treatment.
 - **Persons who are sick** –Sis. Winnifred White, Min. Pike, Bro Joseph Roach, Ms. Salmon. Carlene McKenzie- she has sickle cell, Faith Beckford, Sis. Lovette and Doreen Larmond.
 - **Shut in brethren** Missy. Davy - she suffered a mini stroke in August last year. Sis. Carter, Sis. Copeland, Bro. Issacs as well as Bro. Peddi. He is having challenges with his vision. He is recovering from surgery.

WEEK THREE

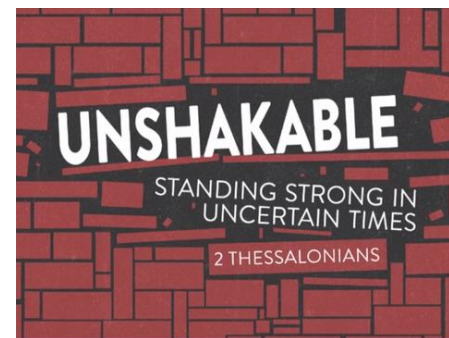
