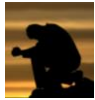

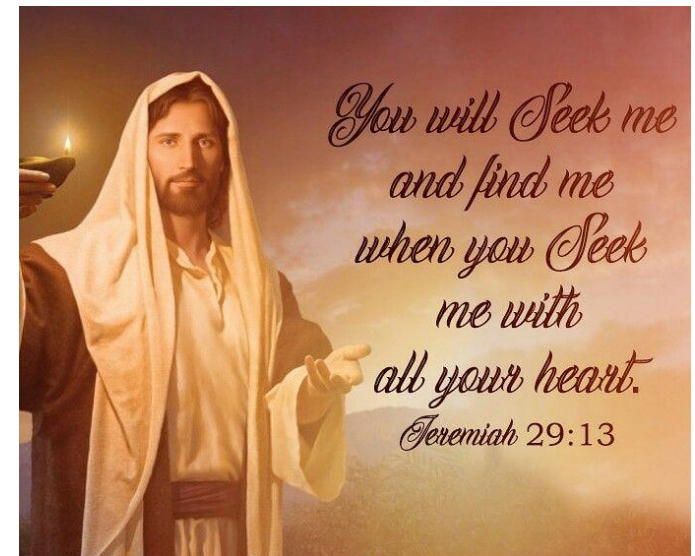

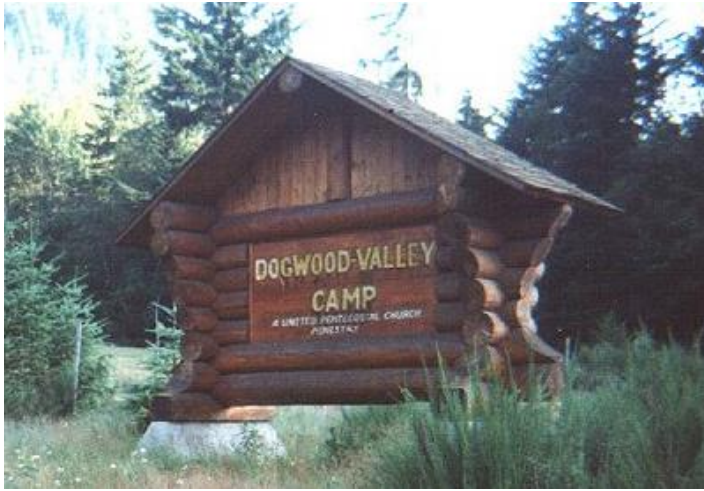
Prayer requests
